**Quick Tips for Parents**

**Read or tell a story EVERY DAY!**  
 Read items aloud wherever you go: food labels, maps, menus, cereal boxes, road signs, etc.

Let your child retell the story.

Show your child the cover page.  
 Explain what the story is about.

Ask your child questions about the story.  
 "What do you think will happen next?"  
 "What is this?"

Make the story come alive.  
 Create voices for the characters; add sounds or animal noises.

Let your child choose the book or story topic at reading time.

Talk about the pictures.  
 You don't have to read the book to tell a story.

Visit your local library often.
